Park information & guidelines

The following information and guidelines are provided to ensure visitors to our tourist parks have an enjoyable stay.

1. Fees

Please ensure that all fees are paid in advance. The boom gate will only function if guests fees are up to date.

2. Check Out/In

Site fees are calculated until 10.00am on the day of departure. If your travel arrangements are inconvenienced by these times please contact the Management to make alternative arrangements.

Cabin Check in:

2pm subject to availability.

3. Vehicles

The safety of our customers is of prime importance. You can assist our cause by limiting the speed of your vehicle to 8 kilometers (walking pace) whilst within the park. Please contact Management if you wish to wash or repair a vehicle on site.

4. Boom Gates

This facility is for your security. To assist the Management please follow directions and do not issue your security pin number to any other person as it will restrict access.

5. Pets

Unfortunately pets and caravan parks do not mix. Please make other arrangement for your pets prior to coming away on holidays.

6. Children

The park and it's facilities are provided for the enjoyment of you and your children. The supervision of your children is important for their safety and to ensure they do not disturb other people in the park.

Children must be accompanied my an adult when visiting the shower or toilets.

7. Scooters, Skateboards, Roller Skates, Roller Blades

The Manager will provide information to guests regarding the nearest safe area available for children to use skateboards, roller skates, roller blades etc. For the benefit of our customers these items are not to be used within the park grounds.

8. Bicycles

Cycles must be ridden on the roads within the park (excluding carpark) at the speed limit of a maximum of 8 kilometers per hour. Please inform your children of the safety requirements and ensure that they wear a safety helmet at all times. In order to prevent accidents, please do not use bicycles after sunset or before sunrise. No Helmet - No Ride!

9. Your Site

Please keep your site tidy and use the facilities provided for drying clothes, discharge of sullage water and rubbish disposal.

10. Noise

The peaceful enjoyment of our parks and their facilities by all visitors is important to us. Please assist by being considerate to your neighbors and restrict noise from radios, televisions and social gatherings in the morning and evening.

11. Amenities

Hot water is available for showers, washing machines and basins. Please consider others and limit time spent in showers and avoid wastage at all times.

12. Garbage

Receptacles are located throughout the park for your convenience. Please assist by wrapping all garbage prior to it's disposal.

13. Telephone Messages

Messages will be placed on the notice board except urgent messages which will be delivered.

14. Securing Your Site

While Park Managers do their best to ensure a safe and secure environment, we do recommend that visitors to the parks take the precaution of securing items of value left outside their tent, caravan or cabin during the day and overnight.
